Holly Zausner's new film "Unsettled Matter" takes place in a deserted New York City, devoid of people and cars except for the artist as a film noir character. It is a film that explores ideas about contemporary alienation, film history, aspects of NY culture. It was filmed on HD 4K by a well known cinematographer Mott Hupfel. In real time the city's iconic locations were made deserted, Grand Central Station, Metropolitan Museum of Art, Film Forum while they are playing L'Avventura, Chinatown, 5 blocks on Broadway, Washington Square Park, Bergdorf Goodman's department store, just to name a few locations.
