Stop-motion animation is the inspiration for this two-person show. *Opens Thu 9*



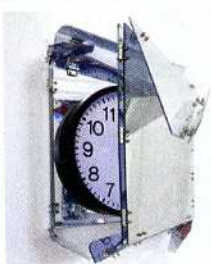
**Polly Apfelbaum + Delia Brown**
