


Paintings from Afghanistan by Steve Mumford




Inspired by Winslow Homer's Civil War studies, which appeared in Harper's Weekly during that conflict,

a bomb buried one hundred yards away.


Steve Mumford is an artist based in New York City. His work from Afghanistan was on view this summer at the Center for Maine Contemporary Art, in Rockport.








